

## **Promoters conditions Orion Club Distance championships September 29th 2019**

### **Introduction**

- The objective of this meet is to adhere to the British Swimming philosophy of providing competition for all and to meet the mission statement "Every swimmer has the opportunity to swim in appropriate, quality competition to enable them to achieve their true potential".
- This competition is held under ASA/swim England Laws and ASA Technical Rules related to the discipline of racing.
- Venue- The venue is King Edwards School, Edgbaston Park Road, Edgbaston, Birmingham, B15 2UA
- The meet is open to all swimmers registered with the ASA and members of Orion swimming Club, .
- Meet entry is £4.50 per event with a minimum of two entries to receive a souvenir t shirt.
- Age is at 27/10/19 and for boys /girls is 8,9,10,11,12,13,14 and Open
- **Closing date for entries is midnight on September 12th<sup>th</sup> 2019**
- Times are as stated in the programme of events but may vary and will be notified on the club website.
- Warm up may be split at the organizer's discretion.
- All starts will be from the deep end of the pool.
- Over-the-top starts, and for Backstroke events side-by-side starts may be used at the Promoter's discretion .

### **Swimming/Spectator Area**

For the purpose of this meet, Team Managers will be responsible for the conduct of their swimmers. It is therefore expected that Team Managers will remain in the designated poolside area and/or with their swimmers at all times.

The following requirements should be brought to the attention of competitors, team staff and spectators. Entry to the swimmers' area is through the changing rooms and onto poolside. Entry to the spectators' seating area is from the entrance at the changing room end of the pool.

The Promoters of this event will adhere strictly to the Health and Safety Laws 203-206. It should be noted that no-one will be permitted into the changing rooms, poolside or swimming/spectator seating area until the Promoters and/or Meet Referee are satisfied that these Health and Safety Rules have been met in full.

### **Data Protection**

All data relating to the entry and results processing will be held on a computer database. Results of the meet will be sent to the ASA within 5 working days for the purposes of ranking.

Swimmer entries will be managed on a computer. By submitting entries, consent is thereby given, as required by the Data Protection Act 1998, to the holding of personal information on computer.

Personal data will be available for inspection during the meet upon request.

Under A.S.A child protection guidelines there will be no photography/image capturing at this event.
